### **Overview**

- Social broadband tariffs are discounted broadband deals available to people receiving Universal Credit and other benefits.
- They could save eligible residents up to £202 a year on their broadband bills.
- Ofcom has revealed that only 5% of eligible households\* are taking advantage of social broadband tariffs.
- The biggest barrier to the take-up of social broadband tariffs is awareness, as most eligible households have never heard of these discounted deals.
